SHORT TERM AUSTRALIAN MISSIONS PROGRAM

Welcome to the **Short Term Australian Missions Program** or **STAMP** as we like to call it. STAMP is a new and exciting program that offers a spiritual, educational and service experience for young Christians in Australia and New Zealand.

The purpose of STAMP is to provide an opportunity for young people (18 to 25+) to participate in a year long program of learning and ministry within Australasia. The course will comprise 6 months of "in class room work" at Gosford, on the Central Coast of NSW, followed by a 6 month field assignment at a congregation within Australasia. Each student can also participate in vocational training using the TAFE (Polytechnic) Open Training & Education Network (OTEN) for the 12 month duration of the program.



What Will STAMP Offer You?

Christian Education

Bible Study is an important part of STAMP. Over 20 weeks, you will cover surveys of the Old and New Testaments, learn about outreach, other beliefs, and the New Testament church. You will gain teaching and presentation skills as well as discovering how to use your gifts and talents in serving God's Kingdom, amongst other things.



Field Assignment



The Field Assignment will be one of the most rewarding and enjoyable parts of STAMP. Imagine spending six months at a congregation helping to encourage, serve, edify, evangelise, as well as building relationships! Being part of STAMP means that you will have an opportunity to spend time in congregations all over Australia and New Zealand - from Auckland to Perth or from Cairns to Invercargill.

Career Guidance and Training

Between 18 and 25 years of age you will make some of the most important decisions of your life. One of them involves what will you do for a job? At STAMP you will have the opportunity to receive some quality career guidance, undertake training online via TAFE (Polytechnic), learn how to pursue job prospects and positively influence prospective employers.
